

Workshop Information and Application Form

The Regional Toolbox for Environmental Change forum is Victoria's premier regional conference for those involved in education for sustainability. Now in its fourth year and held at the Narmbool Discovery Camp, Elaine, south of Ballarat, the forum provides a key networking opportunity for teachers, educators and administrators. In 2012, the focus will be on the effective use of technology in education for sustainability, case studies, VELS curriculum links and ResourceSmart AuSSI Vic, the accredited framework for education about waste, biodiversity and resource conservation.

Greening Australia is now calling for applications from schools, individuals and organisations to run workshops at the 2012 forum. Workshops will run for 60 minutes and will accommodate between 10 - 25 participants. Workshops must be interactive and get participants talking, thinking and working together. Workshops can cover a wide range of topics. However, feedback from previous evaluations has highlighted that workshops involving hands on activities , those involving teacher and student presenters and those linked to the four Resource Modules (water, waste, biodiversity and energy) of the ResourceSmart AuSSI Vic framework were most valuable.

Obviously we encourage a hands-on approach as our fundamental aim is to equip participants with skills and experiences that they can take back to their school communities to promote action for environmental change.
