PTC produces high-end CAD software for large corporations but has made this 'lite' version available with a 300-site license to teachers free of charge through its Design & Technology in Schools Program. To obtain this license, teachers simply undertake a basic two-day training program and complete a small CAD project to demonstrate competency. TEAV is delighted to offer this training. This software is suited to Years 7-12 and is highly recommended. It is very powerful, relatively easy to use and produces both engineering drawings and fully rendered images. It is being used widely in schools overseas and within Australia.

He is one of the State trainers in ProDesktop, and has also introduced the program to the Technology Education students at LaTrobe University. Several of his students have had pieces accepted for "Top Designs", in which they have used ProDesktop software to develop their successful folios.

* *PICAXE CODE 6203*

Participants will construct their own download cable, this will be used to program the PICAXE 08M development board, they will also solder. They will then develop a program and download it to the board. This project will involve a simple flashing LED. The next few exercises will involve use of labels, internal memory locations and some simple manipulations of these memory locations. They will also drive buzzers, RTTL ring tone outputs and motor outputs. One project will involve an Infra Red TV remote control and it will control the output of the PICAXE. Participants will leave the session with new skills, an 08M development board, Infra Red receiver module, download cable, software and programs assisting students in programming the microcontroller.

Participants will learn how to use SolidWorks to build parametric models of parts and assemblies then make drawings of those parts and assemblies. The course emphasizes the process and procedures to be followed in order to complete a particular task. By utilizing case studies to illustrate these processes, participants learn the necessary commands, options and menus in the context of completing a design task. SolidWorks is used widely in manufacturing industries and is an integral component within most Product Design & Engineering degrees that are currently on offer at Melbourne universities.

A free limited version of SolidWorks will be provided to participants.


