Gallery 2 from Thursday 31 January to Saturday 1 March, 2008 **Brenda Page** Once Upon...

There is a theory that personalities are developed and set within the first seven years of childhood. Once Upon a Moment explores the territory of what it is that makes us who we are. Over the past 12 months Brenda Page has been gathering stories from family members and friends, particularly children between five and seven years of age. From these interviews she lists the potent images and symbols that arise to create composite stories that are suggestive and dream-like. These images are then incorporated into and on the glass Page creates. Many of the collected stories relate to defining moments which have transferred their energy into the object, allowing the glass to tell a tale.

The sculptural objects directly relate to early childhood toys such as; skateboards, skates, sling shots, paper airplanes, puzzles and dolls. The work is produced using a variety of kiln forming techniques; fusing, slumping, lost wax casting, painting and screen-printing.

Page notes, "Most work has required many hours of labour with some of the pieces requiring up to 90 hours of firing time in the kiln. I believe the use of glass intensifies the notion of fragility and vulnerability, making the stories more potent".
