Secondary students

We know that industrial design lecturers at Monash University and RMIT look for secondary students who've entered the competition as it shows you're passionate about automotive design. Entering improves your CV and gives you a talking point at interviews. Plus, if you win, your school also receives prize money.

Tertiary students

Many tertiary students become employed by design centres at Ford Australia, GM Holden and Toyota Australia, through their final year project, their VACC Automotive Design Awards entry. The skills and disciplines required by tertiary students at uni to design their entry are those required in the real world by professional automotive designers.

2013 VACC Automotive Design Awards

In June 2013, 250 automotive industry guests attended the Presentation Ceremony at Federation Square. The Hon. David Hodgett, Minister for Manufacturing, Major Projects and Ports, presented the Awards and prize money to winners of the secondary and tertiary essay, model and design categories. The Heads of Design for Ford Australia, GM Holden and Toyota Australia judged the entries and all shortlisted entries were exhibited to the public in the Fracture Gallery, Federation Square.

2013 Secondary student internship and master classes

Ford Australia selected two secondary students for an internship at the Ford Design Centre. All shortlisted secondary entries attended an Industrial Design master class at Monash University and RMIT.

2013 Overseas scholarship

One tertiary entrant was selected for an overseas scholarship of a lifetime, sponsored by the Victorian Government. The recipient could choose the destination, the duration and the timing of the scholarship.
