Designing & Testing a Program: In this computer lab based session you will be guided through a computer game based problem.

Algorithms: This session will teach you a logical way of looking at and approaching the hardest part of the exam, which is the algorithm question. You will be taken through various problems and gain an understanding of techniques and purposes of desk checking.
