'Animate your classroom' Flash for Beginners

Hands-on sessions for
primary teachers

Session overview

ICT provides a rich and flexible learning environment in which students can **experiment and take risks** when developing new understanding.

Students are exposed to animations through movies, the internet and mobile phones. Any form of learning that includes animations appeals to students and this becomes the basis in **motivating** their learning.

Animations therefore become an important tool in teaching and learning, providing a fun aspect to learning, as well as **creativity, higher order thinking**, and outputs that can be kept for future reference or even shared with others.

Flash is a flexible and powerful animations tool, incorporating sound and digital photos. Images can be inserted into web pages. Animations not only develop ICT skills, but can be used to **compliment learning for English, LOTE and Science**.

'Frames' is an alternative to Flash and is suitable for primary years. Katharine Ebbs (Edsoft) will outline this software so teachers are aware of this option.

SOFTWARE FEE SUMMARY

Flash

If your school doesn't already have Adobe Flash, below is a guide to costs for purchasing it. Flash costs approximately \$250 per licence to buy. One licence covers one computer. The more licences bought the cheaper they will be. There are packages available which include Flash and other Adobe programs, for example the CS3 web standard package contains Flash, Dreamweaver, Fireworks, & Contribute. Costs are roughly \$4925 for up to 500 school-owned or leased PCs, which equals \$9.85 for each of the 500 PCs.

Frames

Frames is similar to Flash, but whereas Flash is suitable for year 5 to 12, Frames is most suitable for P to 6. It may be a cheaper alternative for schools without Adobe Flash. Approximate costs are 5 user licence = \$300, 35 user licence = \$1300, unlimited site licences for schools larger than 500 = \$4000, and unlimited site licences for schools smaller than 500 = \$3000
