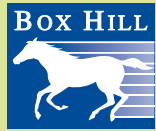

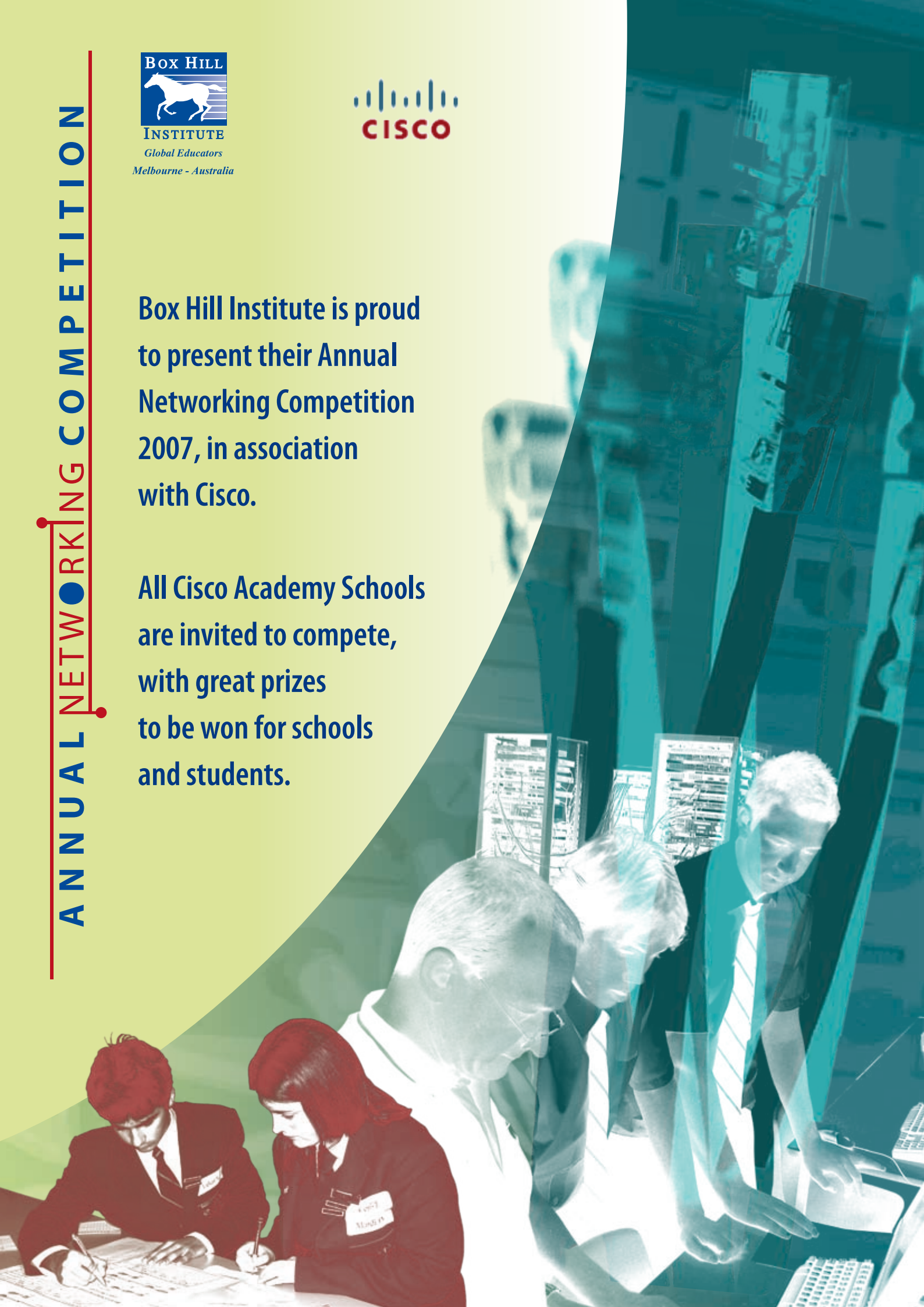

How it works!

1. There are two separate parts of competition:
 - CCNA 1 and 2
 - CCNA 3 and 4

2. Schools register for the competition.
3. Competitors come to Box Hill Institute for two private sessions with our instructors.
4. Schools then compete in the skills competition.
5. Place holders will be presented with awards at their school assembly.

Prizes include routers, switches, software and much more!
2006 prizes totalled a value of \$60,000.
